Health and Safety

- Ally gave us a run down of Health and Safety system – each club to have a log in and to log any accidents or incidents they see – then they are followed up by HMI

Matters arising from March Meeting

- Massey uniforms are delayed – request to wear Navy tops for Div 2 men and women – will change if there is a clash – approved
- Motion to accept March minutes as true and accurate – Tania – Dave seconded –carried

Match Committee

- Discussion held and it was decided that each MANAWATU club will have a contact/representative on the match committee – HMI to coordinate anything that needs a match committee approval and will send a email to the contact people not relating to the clubs involved in the matter. The contact people will then email back to HMI within 24 hours and I decision will then be made by HMI based on this feedback from the club contacts and then the decision published to all.

Protests

- Two current protests received
- 1. HSHC Postman Vrs Massey – protest by Massey that the card was not completed fully before the game and also players not playing in uniforms and not registered but were “fill ins”for the night
 - o Discussion held and protest upheld for Card not being completed and HSHC Postman lose points for this match
- 2. Massey vrs Marist Cavillers – protest by Massey in relation to players playing Div 1,2,3 for Marist. AJ confirmed two players in question were both registered for Div2 Marist team.

- Discussion held, it was discovered that one player had played down into Div 3 for Cavillers and COC agreed that Cavillers will lose all points for games this player played – confirmed as 4
- HMI also advised that Dannevirke card not completed fully for Div 3 men – HMI enforced rules and Dannevirke also lose points for this game

Definition of when competition starts

- Confusion on when the competition rules commence in relation to players and grades etc
- This has not changed – and has been from the first game in the HMI season. This will be written into the competition rules so there can be no more confusion.

Club registration forms

General

- Ice – none available last week – health and safety issue – HMI advised that they are not happy with the rubbish of the ice bags but admit they should have advised clubs of this not just stopped doing the ice. Ice will resume this week but clubs are reminded to use the rubbish bins as if there is constant mess HMI will advise no ICE will be available
- Umpires for Div 3 ladies - Marton was removed from the list – this was an error PNBHS and PNGHS are both to be on the list – one umpire each 3 times a season – HMI advised the dates are on the website

under officials and club duties – HMI are also to find out why the list from the umpires is not being forwarded onto clubs as a reminder. HMI to advise a list of umpires who will do this grade for clubs to pay.

- PNGHS – now training on Monday 3.30-4.30 so no longer a night training
- Massey – why are Central trainings always on Wed as these were supposed to have been spread out so not one club is constantly effected. HMI to follow this up
- HSHC – postman getting more shirts in mean time will go to red if not enough shirts - approved
