Matters Arising:

Competition Entries:

There will not be a Wanganui Women's Div 1 team entered this year – this makes 5 teams in the comp.

PNBHS 2nds will play in the Secondary School comp.

All team entries are to be in to Willy by the 21st March – this means how many teams and what grade.

The deadline for all team members to be entered onto the IMG data base is the 30th March.

Use the classic consol when registering. A maximum of 20 players per team.

Willy will email the link to all clubs.

Clubs are to contact Willy by the 1st March if they require help to enter players on the IMG data base. He will arrange a 'sharing of knowledge' meeting for all interested.

Team lists will still need to be entered on the Hockey Manawatu form. Willy will change the PDF form to Word so that Clubs can access it and make changes.

Competition Draw:

All entries are to be in by the 21st March so that the draw can be done.

General:

Umpires - D Craven asked that Clubs be notified about some small changes in the rules. They will be attached to these minutes.

College – Woody advised that this is his last meeting. He is standing down as chairperson of the College Club. Willy thanked Woody for all his help over several years.

Massey – Daniel advised that the Massey Club is keen to have a team of male high school players under the Massey umbrella. This will be a development team.

Club to club transfers are now to be done through IMG.

Linda asked if the penalty points accrued by players could be sent to the clubs as this is a 12 month time span rather than a season. Willy to action.

Linda asked if we could use young developing umpires for the Women's Div 3 teams. The present club umpiring system for these teams is less than desirable and faces constant criticism by clubs and players. Dave thinks that they would need to have mentors/support with them. It was suggested that they have already been doing this umpiring and being paid a nominal fee by some clubs. A discussion around the payment of umpires followed. It is an ongoing issue and was not resolved.

All agreed that the umpiring of the Div 3 Women needed to be addressed.

Uniform changes – High School will have some teams with different uniforms but still their colours of red and white.

CAPs Women would be wearing white tops – to align with the Men's team
Massey have new uniforms – Navy and White stripes. These would be available and worn about 3 weeks into the season.
