JENNY SMART MEMORIAL BEST SENIOR WOMEN'S PLAYER

The Award shall be made annually in terms of the following criteria:

ELIGIBILITY

1. The period of consideration for this Award is 28 August 2016 to 18 August 2017.
2. Nominees under consideration for this award must meet the following criteria below:
 - Be a financial member of a HMI affiliated club (or school) during the award period
 - Be over the age of 20 as at the 1st January 2017
 - Played a minimum of three club games in the Hockey Manawatu Premier/Division One Competition. Exceptions will be made for those committed to National duty/representation in any given year e.g. Black sticks in an Olympic year
3. The award is open to one nomination per Club

CRITERIA

Open to any player that meets the eligibility criteria above and has performed some notable achievements within the qualified period. Criteria (can include but not limited to):

- Level of achievement (Regional, National, International):
 - Performance at national level ranks above performance at regional level
 - Performance at International level ranks above performance at National level

COACHES ROSEBOWL COACH OF THE YEAR

The Award shall be made annually in terms of the following criteria:

ELIGIBILITY

1. The period of consideration for this Award is 28 August 2016 to 18 August 2017.
2. Nominees under consideration for this award must meet the following criteria below:
 - Open to any coach that has coached a HMI affiliated club/school team, Hockey Manawatu Representative Team, Central Hockey Regional team, or a National team during the award period
 - Nominee must reside in the Manawatu region
3. The award is open to coaches who are paid or unpaid
4. The award is open to one nomination per Club

CRITERIA

The Coach of the Year Award will recognise outstanding performance and/or contribution to their respective teams/players. Criteria (can include but it's not limited to):

- Contribution of the coach to encourage people to start, stay, or succeed in hockey
- Demonstrated coaching quality
- Overall coaching philosophy
- Professional development taken and offered
- Development and support provided for players
- Special qualities that set them apart from others
- Team performance/s at either international, national, regional, or club
- Team results – improvements in position/rankings

VIC TURNER MEMORIAL BEST ALL ROUND TEAM

The Award shall be made annually to a club or secondary school team for excellence in conduct, punctuality, and dress.

ELIGIBILITY

1. The period of consideration for this Award is 28 August 2016 to 18 August 2017.
2. Nominees under consideration for this award must meet the following criteria below:
 - Be a HMI affiliated club or secondary school team during the award period
 - Each club or school may nominate their best team using the criteria below
 - A club or school may nominate any team from another club or school
 - Umpires may nominate any team from a club or school
4. The award is open to one nomination per Club or school

CRITERIA

The Award will recognise excellence in conduct, punctuality, and dress. Criteria (can include but it's not limited to):

- Exceptional conduct on the field of play
- Punctuality for games
- High standard of dress and appearance both on and off the turf
- Number of cards handed out to members of a team during the season
- Defaults incurred by a team during the season
- Any other criteria that sets one team above another that the judging panel see applicable

OBO SENIOR MEN'S UMPIRE SENIOR MEN'S GOALKEEPER OF THE YEAR

1. Open to any past or present member of Hockey Manawatu
2. Nominees under consideration for this award must meet the following criteria below:
 - Be a past or present member of Hockey Manawatu
 - Must be nominated by an affiliated Hockey Manawatu Member, Club, or school
 - Nominees must have rendered a minimum of 10 years of outstanding services to Hockey Manawatu and not for any monetary consideration

CRITERIA

Criteria (can include but not limited to):

- At least ten years' service to Hockey Manawatu
- Service can be in any area of hockey i.e. administrator, member of committee, or a helper in any capacity
- Nomination(s) are to be made by the management committee of an affiliated Club/School
- All nominations will be considered by the HMI Board and the granting of the Service Award will be at the discretion of the Board
- The Service Badge will be awarded on the Manawatu Club Competition Finals Day
